

**NISQUALLY INDIAN TRIBE
REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
Wood Cutter**


The Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe having a governing body and reserved sovereign powers over persons, property and activities within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Nisqually Indian Reservation, located in the State of Washington. The governing representative body of the Tribe, the Nisqually Tribal Council, may enter into contracts with various funding entities to provide services for the members of the Tribe.

A. Scope of Work

The Nisqually Tribe Elders Program is currently seeking a Wood Cutter to perform the duties of Cutting and Delivering wood to elder's homes. Acceptable candidates must be an enrolled Nisqually tribal member, be able to work with minimum supervision, make decisions on own initiative and communicate with individuals and employees. The selected candidate will be required to submit to a police background check.

The successful Wood Cutter candidate:

- Shall deliver wood to elder's homes
- Responsible for stacking wood in designated areas, easy access for elders
- Must have a reliable vehicle that can transport large amounts of wood (truck or trailer) in Thurston County and possibly just outside Thurston's boarder, (fee negotiable for these deliveries).
- Must have equipment to cut wood (chainsaw, saw, axes etc.).
- Skills using proper equipment to cut logs into burnable pieces (10-12 inches)
- Must be able to maintenance own equipment and vehicles including gas.
- Ability to communicate effectively with the program staff, and elders
- Required to collect signature from each elder when delivery is complete.
- Must get their own wood cutting permit for tribe/Fort Lewis
- **Must provide one or more cords of wood that each measures out to 4ft wide x8 ft long x4ft deep**



B. Base Bid

The base price for the Wood Cutter shall be \$_____.00 **per cord of wood** paid by Elders Program.

This position shall report to the Elder's Program Manager.
