The open Tribal Council Vice Chairman and Treasurer positions and Enrollment Committee Treasurer and 6th positions will not be subject to voting in the Primary Election, as each of those open positions drew only two candidates during the Nominations Meeting on Saturday, February 6, 2016. *See* Section 13.02.07(i). Those open seats with two candidates will be subject to voting during the General Election on May 7, 2016.

BALLOTING

For Nisqually eligible voters who will vote in-person during the Primary Election on March 12, 2016, please be sure to bring some form of photo identification such as your Tribal Identification Card or Driver's License.

Pursuant to Section 13.02.13 of the new Title 13, Elections Ordinance, Absentee voting is allowed. An absentee ballot request form is attached. Absentee ballot request forms may otherwise be requested from the Election Committee either at the Nisqually Tribal Administration Building or downloaded from the Nisqually

Tribal website. Any absentee voter shall present a written and originally signed request form to the Committee, in person through the absentee ballot request box the Nisqually Tribal Administration Building Front Desk at the street address above, or by mail through the PO Box address below, **by no later than Monday, February 22, 2016 at 5:00 PM.**

For the Primary Election, **an Absentee Voter must cause his or her original ballot to be received by the Election Committee at the Post Office Box address below by no later than Saturday, March 12, 2016, or that person's ballot shall not be counted by the Election Committee.**

Any person who properly and timely requests an absentee ballot for the Primary Election will also be provided an absentee ballot for the General Election without that person needing to take any further action.
