



The Nisqually Markets is seeking to hire a Freight Handler for our Lakewood location. The Freight Handler is essentially responsible for moving all stock, freight, or other materials in order to perform general labor.

The duties for the Freight Handler position are as followed:

- Compiles & maintains records of quantity, type, merchandise, or supplies stocked in establishment.
- Counts material, merchandise, or supplies in stock.
- Compares inventories to office records or computes figures from records, such as sales orders, or purchase invoices to obtain current inventory costs totals to inventory records, manually or using computer.
- Verifies clerical computations against physical count of stock & adjusts errors in computation or count, or investigates & reports reasons for discrepancies.
- Compiles information on receipt or disbursement of material, equipment, merchandise, or supplies, & computes inventory balance, price, and cost.
- Stock and issue materials or merchandise.
- Other duties as assigned.

The requirements for Freight Handler position are as followed:

- 5 years or more of inventory/freight experience.
- Must be able to lift up to 75 pounds throughout an entire day.
- Must be able to work in a cooler for up to 4 hours in one day.
- Must be able to work well with others while paying attention to detail.
- Knowledge of supplies, equipment, and/or services ordering and inventory control.
- Ability to reconcile stock counts to report data.
- Strong database management and communication skills.
- Ability to analyze and solve problems.
- Ability to prepare routine administrative paperwork.
- Ability to receive, stock, and/or deliver goods.
- Clerical, word processing, and/or office skills.
- Knowledge of invoicing procedures.
