

NISQUALLY INDIAN TRIBE
EMERGENCY REGULATION 2-2023/2024

July 31, 2023

In accordance with Section 14.23.02 of Nisqually Tribal Code, Title 14-Chapter 2, as amended by the Tribal Council effective 7/1/91, the Nisqually Fish Commission has adopted the following fishery modification effective August 9th, 2023 for **McAllister Creek 83F**.

Regulation Modified: None
SPECIES: CHINOOK
Fishery Type: Commercial

Gear Type: Gill Net, Beach Seine, Pound Trap, Weir, Fish Wheel
Area: **McAllister Creek (83F)** Freshwater courses upstream of Luhr Beach Boat Launch.

Days and hours open: 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Wednesday through Friday
August 9th through September 8th

Monday through Wednesday
September 11th through October 25th

McAllister Commercial Regulations as defined by 2023 Annual Regulations:

1. Commercial and C+S Fisheries -Any combination of 2 gill nets **per** active fisher combined cannot exceed 250 feet in length. No singular set net can exceed 125 feet in length. No drift gill net can exceed 70 feet in length.
2. No GN net shall exceed beyond 2/3 the width of the channel below I-5 on McAllister Creek at low tide.
3. All nets shall be clearly identified with NISQ and fishing ID number with letters no less than 1" in height. Buoys from recycled jugs from nontoxic products only.
4. All nets can be tended only by owner and or authorized assistant-"active fisher". Gill nets shall be tended not less than once every 24 hours.
