


Biface



Artifact Type: Biface

Material: CCS (Cryptocrystalline Silicate) and CVR (Crystalline Volcanic Rock)

Description: A type of prehistoric stone tool that has been flaked on both sides (faces). This tool had many uses which made it a versatile tool. The cutting edge could be straight or jagged and the tool was used as a pick, knife, scraper, or even weapon.
