

Infant Formula Recall Alert

Possible link to infant botulism cases. The CDC, FDA, and Washington State DOH are investigating an outbreak of infant botulism linked to ByHeart Whole Nutrition Infant Formula. Thirteen infants in ten states have been affected, including one in Washington.

If you have ByHeart formula:

- Do not use it — throw it away or return it.
- Record the lot number before discarding.
- Clean any items or surfaces that touched the formula
- *If you have concerns or questions, contact your baby's healthcare provider.*

Seek medical care immediately if your baby shows:

- Poor feeding
- Weak head control
- Trouble swallowing
- Reduced facial expression

Symptoms can take weeks to appear. Stay alert if your baby has the recalled formula.
