Guidelines

To Apply for Support:

Please read the general guidelines below to determine if your organization or project qualifies for Charitable Funds or Local Government.

Application:

Each organization will be allowed only one application yearly.

To Qualify for Local Government:

The organization must be non-tribal, organized to provide emergency services and/or service agencies (including those agencies responsible for traffic and transportation), or be a Law Enforcement Agency.

To Qualify for Charitable Funds:

The organization must be registered as a 501 (c)(3) tax exempt status with the Internal Revenue Service and be within Washington State. (Please note that Thurston County will be the main priority of funding, then if funds remain other locations may be considered).

- Address on application must match the W-9 address
- If you are claiming 501(c)(3) status you must attach official documentation
- All applications are due by **October 29, 2021**
- Completed applications are to be either emailed or mailed to:
- Prior year recipients must provide pictures and narrative of how funds were utilized
