The process of making such a club is through pecking and grinding the stone to the desired shape and size. Stone materials of this type have been in use for thousands of years prior to being lost beneath the earth and collected by Europeans. These types of clubs were used to club fish as they were caught and in times of conflict they doubled as weapons.
