### TRIBAL ID AND/OR DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIRED TO VOTE

**In Person Balloting** - For Nisqually eligible voters who will vote in-person during the General Election on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016, please remember to bring your Tribal ID or Washington State Identification.

**Absentee Balloting** – Pursuant to Section 13.02.13 of the New Title 13, Elections Ordinance, Absentee Voting is allowed. An Absentee Ballot Request Form is enclosed. Any Absentee Voter shall present a written and originally signed Absentee Request Form to the Election Committee in person through the Absentee Ballot Request box in the NIT Administration Building, Reception Desk at 4820 She Nah Num Dr. SE, Olympia, WA 98513 or via USPS Mail to the post office box listed below, by no later than Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 5:00 PM.

Only the Absentee Voter is allowed to present his/her Absentee Ballot Request Form to the Election Committee. Any person who properly and timely requested an Absentee Ballot for the Primary Election will also be provided an Absentee Ballot for the General Election without needing to take any further action.

For the General Election, an Absentee Voter must cause his or her original Absentee Ballot to be **received** by the Election Committee **at the Post Office box** address listed below **no later than Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016** or that persons Absentee Ballot *shall not* be counted by the Election Committee.

Any person wanting to vote by Absentee Ballot should carefully read Section 13.02.13 of the new Title 13, Elections Ordinance, to learn more information. It is available on the NIT website and can also be obtained from the Election Committee at the NIT Administration Building.

*Absentee Ballots will **not** be accepted in-person*
