Incomplete site plans will not be accepted \bullet Site plan shall be legible and drawn to a standard engineer scale (example: 1'' = 30' or 1'' = 100') on 11×17 or smaller sheet. \bullet Site plan shall be prepared in black ink. Colored site plans or aerial photographs are accepted in certain situations \bullet All applicable items noted below shall be addressed on the site plan. \bullet Use two site plans for large parcels that do not fit on an 11×17 sheet. One overall site plan showing the entire property and one detail of the area to be developed.
