This includes:

- Always treat people and horses with kindness.
- Take your time with horses, allowing them time to adjust and warm up/cool down from the activity.
- Use language that is supportive and friendly, no cuss words at any time.
- No use of vape or cigarettes or other.
- Should a situation arise that has troubled you please contact your nearest staff member immediately for assistance.
- Please check with staff before removing tack from the area that it is assigned.
- When in a group activity please participate and listen to the instructors.
- Always close gates behind you and close chain.
- Put away all the tack and grooming tools where they belong when you are finished.
- Take your coat & personal items and please throw away your garbage before leaving.
