To Apply for Support:

Please review the general guidelines below to determine whether your organization meets eligibility requirements for Charitable Contributions funding.

Application:

Each organization may submit one application per funding year.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for Charitable Contributions funding, organizations must:

- Be registered as a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt nonprofit with the IRS
- Provide services within Washington State
- Be in good standing with any prior Nisqually awards

Please note: Priority consideration is given to organizations serving Thurston County. Applications from other Washington counties may be funded as resources allow.

Application Guidelines

- The address listed on the application must match the submitted W-9
- An official IRS 501(c)(3) determination letter is required
- Complete applications are due **July 31, 2026**
- Applications are accepted via **email or USPS only** for tracking purposes

Application Completeness

To ensure a smooth and timely review process, applications must include all required checklist items. Incomplete submissions may be deemed ineligible for review. Applicants are encouraged to carefully verify that all materials are included prior to submission.

Required Submission Checklist

Please confirm that your application packet includes the following:

- Attached 501 (c)(3) status verification form.
- W-9 form with current address.
- Completed Application (no more than 4 pages front and back.)
- List all funding sources for this year's project, how much you have received and the outcome you hope to achieve.
