

NISQUALLY INDIAN TRIBE
EMERGENCY REGULATION 7-2025/26
December 16, 2025

In accordance with Section 14.23.02 of Nisqually Tribal Code, Title 14-Chapter 2, as amended by the Tribal Council effective 7/1/91, the Nisqually Fish Commission has adopted the following fishery modification effective December 17, 2025 for the Nisqually River.

Regulation Modified: 6

SPECIES: Chum

Closed: December 17th at Noon.

Fishery Type: Subsistence: Personal subsistence consumption by tribal members and their immediate families.

No sale of any kind permitted including egg sales.

Gear Type: 1 Gillnet per boat. 20 fish total per boat per week.

Area: Nisqually River mouth to Mouth of Clear Creek.

SPECIAL SPECIES CONCERN: GREEN AND WHITE STURGEON

FISHERY TYPE: INCIDENTAL; ALL STURGEON CAUGHT DURING ANY DIRECTED FISHERY IS TO BE RELEASED ALIVE.

Justification: Commercial fishery opening
